

#### **Yard Waste Collection**

- Yard waste, comprised of grass clippings, leaves/weeds, plant trimmings, and/or twigs, is collected and recycled locally to make mulch and keeps our sewers and storm drain systems clean and clear of debris.
- Collection services are offered year round for a fee of \$2 per container with sticker and \$2.50 without sticker.
- These stickers are not required during the city's free one time (lx) yard waste collection service held in the Spring and Fall.
  - Residents can also take their yard waste to **Evans Recycling** during the month of free collection at no charge.

#### **Branch Collection**

- Pickup takes place in the Spring (May-June) and in the Fall (October-November).

- Place branches curbside for pickup while small branches can be broken and put into yard waste paper bags.
- City residents may also take branches to Evans Recycling year round with proof of residency.

# Large Item Pickup



- All city residents are eligible for free scheduled residential curbside pickup twice (2x) per calendar year.
- Pickup can be divided into two (2) small scheduled pickups of three (3) items per pickup or one (1) bulk scheduled pickup of six (6) items.
- This pickup service is exclusive to nonelectronic or non-hazardous items.

# Electronic Recycling Collection



- All city residents can take electronic items such as computers and related equipment, DVD/VCR's, cell phones, stereos, etc. to BLH Computers, Inc., at no charge.
- The city's program also allows all city residents to drop off a maximum of three (3) chargeable items per city address over the course of one (1) calendar year, at no charge. These items include:

- CRT TV's - Projection TV's

- CRT Monitors - Non-LCD/Plasma

- Consoles
